

Auditions will be December 10, 11, and 12 after school in the chorus room. Callbacks will be on Thursday, December 13 in room 1-108. Audition sign ups will be outside the theatre room (1-108) starting on Wednesday, December 5. You will sign up for one 5 minute slot either before school, during 6th or 8th grade lunch, or afterschool. Please only sign up for one spot.

Putting on a show is a huge time commitment, but is one of the most rewarding experiences. We have all done theatre, and cannot wait to help the next generation of stars.

The audition will consist of you reading two scenes and singing a song, which are provided in the packet. It is not necessary to memorize the lines for the audition. Come in prepared, and have a good knowledge of the scene and context.

A final cast list will be posted on **December 14**th at the conclusion of 7th period

Character Breakdown- Majority can be either male or female

Ladahlord

A strange, magical storyteller. Often inserts himself into the story, in disguise, to help push the action forward.

James

A lonely young boy who lacks confidence. Having lost both his parents in a freak accident, he feels he belongs nowhere in the world. However, when given the right encouragement he becomes resourceful and innovative. A good friend.

Spiker

James' mean aunt. A thief and a scoundrel. Shrewd and opportunistic.

Sponge

James' other mean aunt. Also a thief and a scoundrel, but not nearly as bright as her sister. Very corpulent, she often has her mind on food.

Spider

A normal spider who has become human-sized after eating a crocodile tongue. Her husband was killed and eaten by Spiker and Sponge. She is warm and friendly to James

Green Grasshopper

A wizened grasshopper who has become human-sized after eating a crocodile tongue. An excellent musician. Has his eye on Ladybug.

Centipede

An ornery centipede who becomes human-sized after eating a crocodile tongue. Hates humans, in part because Spiker and Sponge fumigated his family. Prickly and rude, everyone thinks he is a pest.

Ladybug

A motherly ladybug who has become human-sized after eating a crocodile tongue. Respectable and classy, she has a warm, caring heart. Has her eye on Grasshopper.

Earthworm

An earthworm who has become human-sized after eating a crocodile tongue. A bit of a scaredy-cat. He is neurotic and worried about everything, but is very friendly and brave when called upon.

Ensemble

Crowd, Karl Kreatour, Reporters, Vagrants, Garden Guild, Bobby-Cops, Willy Wonka, Oompa Loompas, Hollywood Agents, Seaugulls, New Yorkers.

Play Synopsis:

Roald Dahl's fantastical tale of a boy, his insect friends and their amazing journey across the ocean on a giant piece of fruit.

Roald Dahl's James and the Giant Peach is now a musical for the whole family to enjoy! Featuring a wickedly tuneful score by the Tony Award-nominated team of Pasek and Paul (Dogfight and A Christmas Story the Musical) and a curiously quirky book by Timothy Allen McDonald (Roald Dahl's Willy Wonka, The Musical Adventures of Flat Stanley), critics rave: James and the Giant Peach is a "masterpeach!"

When James is sent by his conniving aunts to chop down their old fruit tree, he discovers a magic potion that results in a tremendous peach... and launches a journey of enormous proportions. Suddenly, James finds himself in the center of the gigantic peach, among human-sized insects with equally oversized personalities, but after it falls from the tree and rolls into the ocean, the group faces hunger, sharks and plenty of disagreements. 

The MATRON NURSE spits a loogie into her hand, rubs her hands together and then attempts to calm JAMES' wild hair with her hands and fresh loogie gel.

JAMES

But where am I to go?

MATRON NURSE

They've found family to take you in.

JAMES

But, I don't have any family.

MATRON NURSE

You've got two aunts. They live in Dover.

The MATRON NURSE puts a tie around JAMES' neck.

Dover? But, that's where I lived with my Mum and Dad—

JAMES

MATRON NURSE

impatiently)

And now it's where you're gonna live with your aunties. Pack your things in 'ere.

The MATRON NURSE hands JAMES a small suitcase.

JAMES

Yes, Mum.

IAMES folds his father's glasses inside his mother's scarf carefully and places them inside the suitcase.

MATRON NURSE

That's all you've got? No clothes? No toothbrush? picking up the scarf and glasses)

JAMES

(taking the glasses and scarf back)

These belonged to my parents, and they are the most important things in the entire world to me.

MATRON NURSE

The most important thing from here on is your aunties. You do everything they ask of you. Don't talk back, or be a nuisance. You can't ever come back here James. You've got a family to take care of you now.

Yes, Mum.

MATRON NURSE

Come along. We're gonna have to 'urry if we're gonna make the train to Dover.

LADAHLORD stands and begins to cross slowly towards

IAMES

If you come any closer, I'll scream for my aunts.

LADAHLORD

And what makes you think those two hideous creatures would come running to your rescue?

JAMES

They're my family.

LADAHLORD

Ha! Says who?

That's what I've been told.

LADAHLORD

To get your undivided attention.

Not recipes— No! Potions, tonics, spells! Now, you must pick a spell from the book, devour the potion, and fabulous, unbelievable things will happen to you!

SPIKER

We've got bigger problems than the boy. Did you read any of them contracts we signed?

SPONGE

Only the parts about the money comin' in advance.

SPIKER

Do you know what an <u>advance</u> is?

SPONGE

Yeah, it's oodles of money we get for signing them contracts.

SPIKER

It's money paid in advance...

SPONGE

In advance of what?

SPIKER

magazines, movies! Can't do any of 'em without a bloomin' Delivering on all them promises we made! TV appearances, giant peach.

SPONGE

So, this is bad?

SPIKER

It's worse than bad, you twit! We could go to jail.

SPONGE

I can't go to jail, the food is wholly unacceptable to a sophisticated palate such as mine. SPONGE removes a spray can of whipped cream from her purse. SPONGE sprays the whipped cream directly into her mouth.

SPIKER

Are you quite finished?

SPONGE squirts one more squirt into her mouth.

I am now.

SPIKER

Spongers, we've gotta get out of here before anyone misses that peach!

An ANGRY CROWD enters the stage.

- I will attend all scheduled performances and dress rehearsals and clear all conflicts now!!!!
- I will attend occasional morning and lunch rehearsals with Mr. Cohen. 2. These rehearsals will be set on an as needed basis.
- I will make no plans during production week (April 19-27). Free time that 3. week will be spent in rehearsal for the show.
- 4. If the show runs into trouble (for example, school is canceled due to bad weather or we simply need more rehearsal) I will attend additional evening or weekend rehearsals.
- I will spend my own time and energy learning my part (words, movement) 5. as well as the actual rehearsal time.
- I will be prompt for rehearsals and attend all rehearsals as scheduled for my part in the show. Rehearsals start at 4:00 sharp (not walking in, but ready and warmed up) in the chorus room unless otherwise specified. All rehearsals will end at 5:30 unless otherwise stated

- If I do not sell 100 dollars worth of ad sales by April 1, I am financially responsible to pay the difference
- I will approach each rehearsal with enthusiasm, energy, and a positive 9. attitude.
- 10. I understand that I am responsible for getting pieces of my costume. A list will be provided, but all costumes need to be approved by April 5th

- 11. I can devote the time required for participation in *James* without it interfering with my academic achievement.
